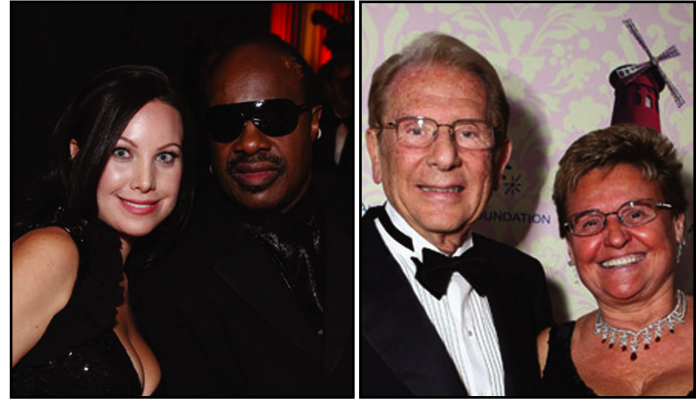
The Alfred Mann Foundation's 4th black-tie gala took place at the Millennium Biltmore downtown instead of at the Mann's Mulholland estate.
